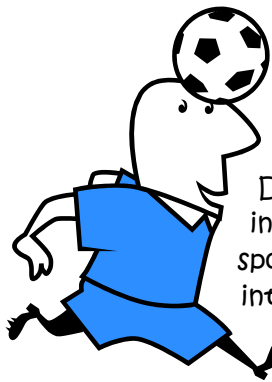

JUNIOR WINTER SPORTS DAY

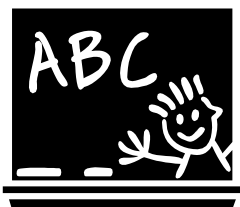

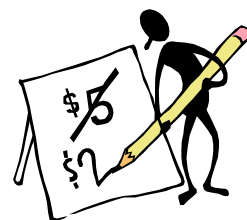
AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS

This is the month that the year 6 children must 'show off' their talents in English, Maths and Science. This will happen in the week beginning



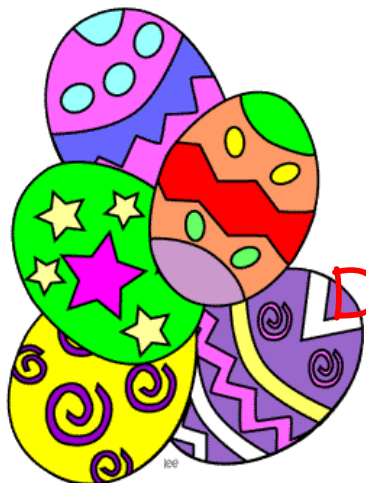
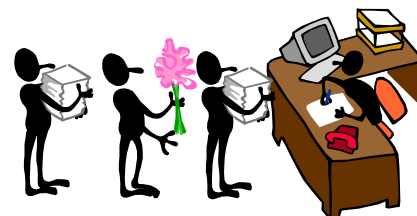
