PARENT CONSULTATIONS

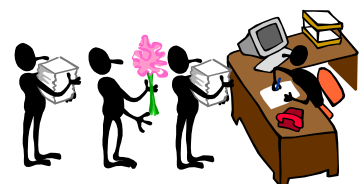
This term, you will have the opportunity to meet with your child's teacher to discuss their Spring report and your child's progress.

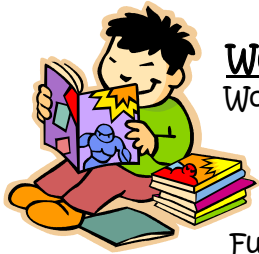
Your child's school report will be sent to you on Friday February 27th.
