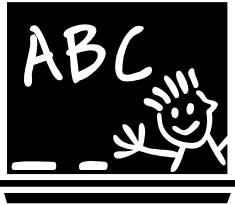
On this day, please could you ensure your child has the correct PE kit - tracksuit bottoms and sweat top, a drink and suitable footwear.

This is the month that the year 6 children must 'show off' their talents in English, Maths and Science. This will happen in the week beginning



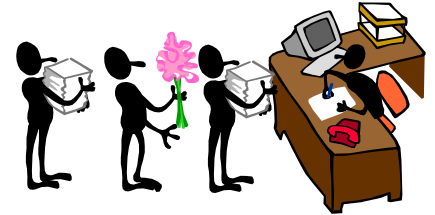
