YOUR ACTION AS PARENTS

- Ask the Headteacher in advance for special permission for any absence other than illness.
 (Forms available from the Office)
- Contact the school on the first day of absence as soon as possible after 8.30 a.m.
- If possible, write a note to explain the reason for the absence when your child returns to school.
- Ensure your child arrives at school
 on time for the start of the school

- Children only attend school for a maximum of 190 days a year. Help your child to make the most of this valuable time.
- Unnecessary absence allowed by parents (condoned) can lead to truancy later.
- Children who arrive late miss a vital part of the day.
- You are legally required to ensure your child attends school regularly and arrives on time.

OUR ACTION IN SCHOOL

- The Headteacher must decide
 whether the reason for absence is
 acceptable.
- We will check that your child is in school every morning and afternoon.
- We will follow up any unexplained absences by contacting parents on the first day of absence.
- Regular attendance and lateness will be monitored and referred to the Education Welfare Officer if necessary.

Regular attendance at school is important for your child's education and is a legal requirement. Responsibility for this rests with the parents.

Condoned absence now can lead to truancy later.

- Extended weekend breaks
- Days out
- Birthday treats which involve absence
- ♦ Shopping Treats
- Visiting relatives

These may all be reasons for being absent from school and by condoning them you may be encouraging bad attendance habits.
